

Instructions

CAUTION - For children 5 years and over. Parental supervision required.
Read these instructions before use – follow them and keep for future reference.

IMPORTANT – Do not eat plaster powder or apply to body. Do not inhale plaster dust. Avoid contact with eyes. If contact with eyes occurs, flush with clean water. Seek medical attention immediately if swallowed or inhaled.

WARNING – This product contains magnets which may cause serious or fatal injury if swallowed. Seek medical attention immediately if ingested. Do not use magnets around items that are sensitive to or affected by magnetic fields.

Always work on a flat, solid surface and remember to place newspaper or a drop sheet down to protect your table or bench. Keep the work area clean.

Do not put the plaster powder down the sink or in the toilet – it may clog your drains.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS YOU WILL NEED

- Water
- Newspaper or drop sheet

HOW TO MIX, MOULD & PAINT

250gms of plaster powder is enough for 1 tray of magnets. Put the water in the mixing tray, add plaster gradually to create a runny consistency. Mix well. (If too dry add more water). Remember to work quickly as plaster thickens quickly. Room temperatures may vary the amount of water you need to use. Water quantities required may vary on each occasion. Remember adult supervision of this step is recommended.

The plaster mix may become warm, this is a normal reaction.

Pour the plaster mix into the moulds.

WARNING: Pour moulds quickly after mixing plaster.

Before the moulds set, press the magnets into the mixture. Make sure to leave the surface of the magnets exposed.

Allow the mould to set. This will take around 30 minutes depending on the viscosity of the mixture.

Once the plaster has fully hardened, remove gently from the tray.

Fridge magnets may be slightly sanded to smooth any rough edges.

Allow the plaster to dry completely before painting. This may take up to 24 hours.

Paint your Funky Fridge Magnets with the paints and brush provided.

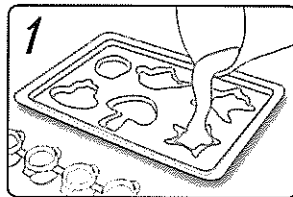
TIP

Blue + Red = Purple

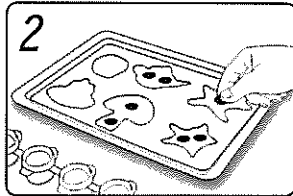
Red + Yellow = Orange

Yellow + Blue = Green

Mix the plaster & pour into mould provided
