

How to make an Owl Tea Light



WHAT YOU NEED

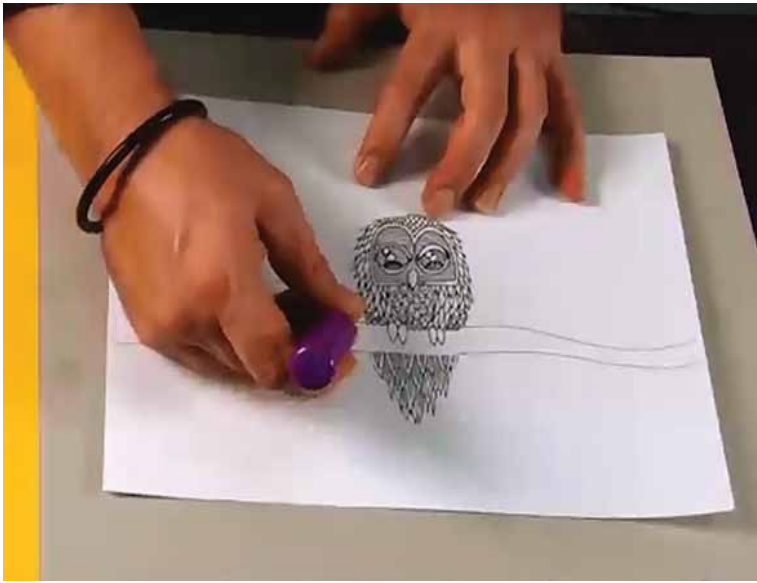
MSB0016 MONT MARTE TRACING PAPER A3 PAD
MSB0059 MONT MARTE BLACK PAPER SKETCH PAD
PMHS0015 MONT MARTE GLASS PAINT 12 PCG 4 ML

A CLEAN EMPTY JAR

Step 1 Adult supervision required for this step

Cutting the Owl in negative - Take the image of the Owl and using a hobby knife cut it out. Use the backside of the Black paper pad as a cutting surface.

When using a hobby knife remember to always cut away from your person. Always use a cutting mat of some sort to protect the surface your cutting on.

Step 2 Adult supervision required for this step

Cutting the light mask - Take the Owl negative and place it over Black paper and trace the negative shape with a pencil. With a hobby knife profile cut to this pencil line.





Step 3

Transferring the Owl onto tracing paper - Next take the second printed image and lay some tracing paper over it and with a Mont Marte fine tip marker trace the image. You might want to tape it into position before you start drawing it.



Step 4

Assembling the lamp - Once the mask and tracing is complete we can assemble it. So first take the Black mask and wrap it around the jar, tape the edges together and then snip the overlapping edge off with scissors. Remove the Black sleeve and wrap the tracing around it ensuring the tracing lines up with the cut out negative. Once in position tape the edges.



Step 5

Painting the jar - In this step the jar gets coloured so when a light sits inside it the glow will be coloured. To do this I'm using the Mont Marte Glass paint and I'm painting a Red, Yellow, Green and Blue, but of course you could paint it any colour you like.



Step 5 Adult supervision required for this step

Lighting the lamp - Once the lamp is dry place the sleeve over it and then place a lit candle inside it. You can use a tea candle or a birthday cake handle.
